



## Methodology






Dates	30 <sup>th</sup> May to 4 <sup>th</sup> June 2018
Location	Zimbabwe
Coverage	All 10 provinces
Target	Registered voters
Data collection	Face to face interviews, respondents sampled from households
Sample Size	3,005 respondents
Margin of Error	+/- 2.19%

### Sample Distribution

- The sample was distributed across the provinces proportionate to population size.
- The sample was weighted against the voter register demographics of age and gender.




## **General Issues**



#### Direction Country is Heading

- 55% of the respondents feel that the country is heading in the right direction.
- On the contrary, 30% feel that the country is heading in the wrong direction.



*All respondents* n=3,005;


*Q. Generally speaking do you think Zimbabwe as a country is heading in the right or wrong direction?*




Majority (54%) MDC Alliance supporters feel that the country is heading in the wrong direction.

### Most Pressing Problems in Zimbabwe




The most pressing problem is cash shortages followed by unemployment and poverty.


*Q.* What are the biggest problems facing you and the people living in your area?





### Political Party Support (By Gender)










